I would especially like to thank Bill McEachern and the rest of the board for helping me take on my duties as 2011 President. Their advice and input is invaluable. I am looking forward to a wonderful year working with all of them and the rest of the BGRC membership.

BGRC General Membership Meeting Minutes

Thunder Bay Grille, Waukesha, WI
January 30, 2011

The meeting was called to order at 1:18 pm by President Bill

McEachern. Bill thanked everyone for attending the banquet and meeting. Bill asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the November 14, 2010 general membership meeting. Steven Scherber so moved; Julie Strey Johnson seconded. The minutes were unanimously approved.

President's Report: Bill distributed and discussed the 2010 annual report of club activities he prepared. He explained the membership information where BGRC has had approximately 60 members over the past few years and remains stable. He also mentioned the publishing of a list of volunteer activities which appeared in the newsletter and is on the website.

The Breeder Referral Program policies and practices were reviewed and revised. BGRC is maintaining the voice messaging system with personal follow-up by the breeder referral contact person.

The Specialty raffle sharing program with GRRoW was revised due to increasing costs and changing staffing needs. Bill explained the 2010 Hunt Test was cancelled due to staffing needs and event timing. However, the 2011 Hunt Test will be held on June 18, 2011 and will be chaired by Steven Scherber.

Bill reported the Nominating Committee recruited officer and board candidates for 2011. Nominated officers are Susan Scherber, President; Sandy Stoller, Vice President; Joan Kaml, Treasurer; and Carol Pacetti, Secretary. Nominated directors are: Jean Taylor, Conformation; Sandy Flaaten, Obedience; Dan Feisthommel, Field; and Jan Nyland, At Large. Bill thanked the 2010 board and officers for their service.

During the year, the 1999 BGRC Operating Policies were updated. The Recognition and Achievement Awards were revised reflecting the original purpose as well as clarifying and redefining procedures. This will be discussed under New Business.

Members contributed to a Wisconsin theme food basket for the National Specialty Raffle.

Bill mentioned the club hosted several events during 2010, including the two-day Specialty, Fun Field Days, The Highland Games education booth, two Correction Matches, the WC/WCX test in addition to providing a booth and demos for the GRRoW Tails on Trails event.

2011 plans include the June 18, 2011 Hunt Test, Correction Matches, the WC/WCX test, and the 2012 Specialty.

Bill thanked Jean Granger for handling the Sunshine duties. Jean Granger and Lynn Guerdnt were also thanked for being the Breeder Referral Persons for part of 2010 and Edell Schaefer who resumed these duties along with being the GRCA Delegate and columnist. He also thanked Susan and Steven Scherber for their work with the GRRoW Tails on Trails event, developing a BGRC scrapbook, and the 2011 Hunt Test. Deb Klemp was thanked for her work with the two-day Highland Games on Labor Day weekend and her submission of photos taken at club events which have appeared in newsletters. Wendy Biewer was thanked for being the legislative liaison. Bill thanked the Nominating Committee, Jan Nyland, Josie Trad and Shirley Wolcyk for their work, and thanked Julie Strey Johnson for handling the Annual Awards. He also thanked Sandi Haessler for her work as the 2011 Special Chair, all Specialty workers and club members who

helped with the WC/WCX and the two Correction Matches.

Secretary's Report: Carol said she had prepared the November nomination letter and mailed it out with the help of Jan Nyland. She also prepared ballot packets which were sent out in early January. Twelve ballots were returned.

Treasurer's Report: Joan reported having a positive balance in the BGRC checking account and also making a profit for 2010.

Membership: Sandy Stoller reported new members to be voted on today couldn't attend this meeting. Sandy also asked members for ideas for programs at general membership meetings. Members should contact board members with ideas which will be discussed at the February, 2011, board meeting.

Specialty: Sandi Haessler said she still needs help for the Specialty. A Chief Ring Steward is needed. She also needs help for the Thursday set-up in the afternoon and Saturday clean-up and tear-down. Joan added she is in need of entries.

Old Business: None.

New Business: Revisions to the Recognition and Achievement Awards were distributed to members. The revisions are:

- Clarified that awards are offered for agility, conformation, field, obedience, tracking and rally titles.
- Eligibility for awards is being an active voting member which is defined as: (1) payment of dues prior to December 31 of the previous year; (2) attending two general membership meetings, and (3) contributing at least five hours of service to a club event, activity or elected position in the qualifying year.

- In order to receive a plaque, the first title must be a GRCA certificate or AKC title.
- In cases of co-ownership, the co-owner's information and signature is required as part of the application. An area for co-ownership information was added to the application form. As in the past, the dog must be living with the member applicant throughout the applying year and the primary owner(s) must meet all of the requirements of being an active voting member. The requirements related to professional handlers remain the same.
- All wins for awards must be reported by December 1 of the qualifying year. After that date, titles must be called in or e-mailed to the chair by an established deadline.
- Awards will be given out at the annual banquet; none will be mailed.
- The requirements for Outstanding Producer remain the same.
- The purchase of plaques by associate and voting members was eliminated. Only one plaque will be provided for a dog. Duplicate plaques are not provided by the club and cannot be purchased.
- The Hammerlock Award was revised and conformation wins must be at a bench show.
- A list of Frequently Asked Questions was added to the awards packet to help clarify requirements.

Bill asked for a motion to accept these revisions. Joan Kaml so moved. Jean Taylor seconded. The motion carried unanimously. The revised policies and procedures will be available on the BGRC web site.

Other: Since no board positions were contested, Bill asked for a motion to unanimously elect the

2011 board consisting of: Susan Scherber, President; Sandy Stoller, Vice President; Joan Kaml, Treasurer; Carol Pacetti, Secretary; Dan Feisthommel, Field; Jean Taylor, Conformation; Sandy Flaaten, Obedience, and Jan Nyland, At Large. Sandi Haessler so moved; Julie Strey Johnson seconded. The motion carried unanimously. Bill turned over his folders to newly elected President Susan Scherber.

Adjournment: Bill asked for a motion to adjourn. Joan Kaml so moved. Jean Taylor seconded. All approved. The meeting was adjourned at 1:45 pm.

Lucky stood watching Mary but he didn't come to her when she called. It made Mary sad but sleep soon overcame her and she dozed.



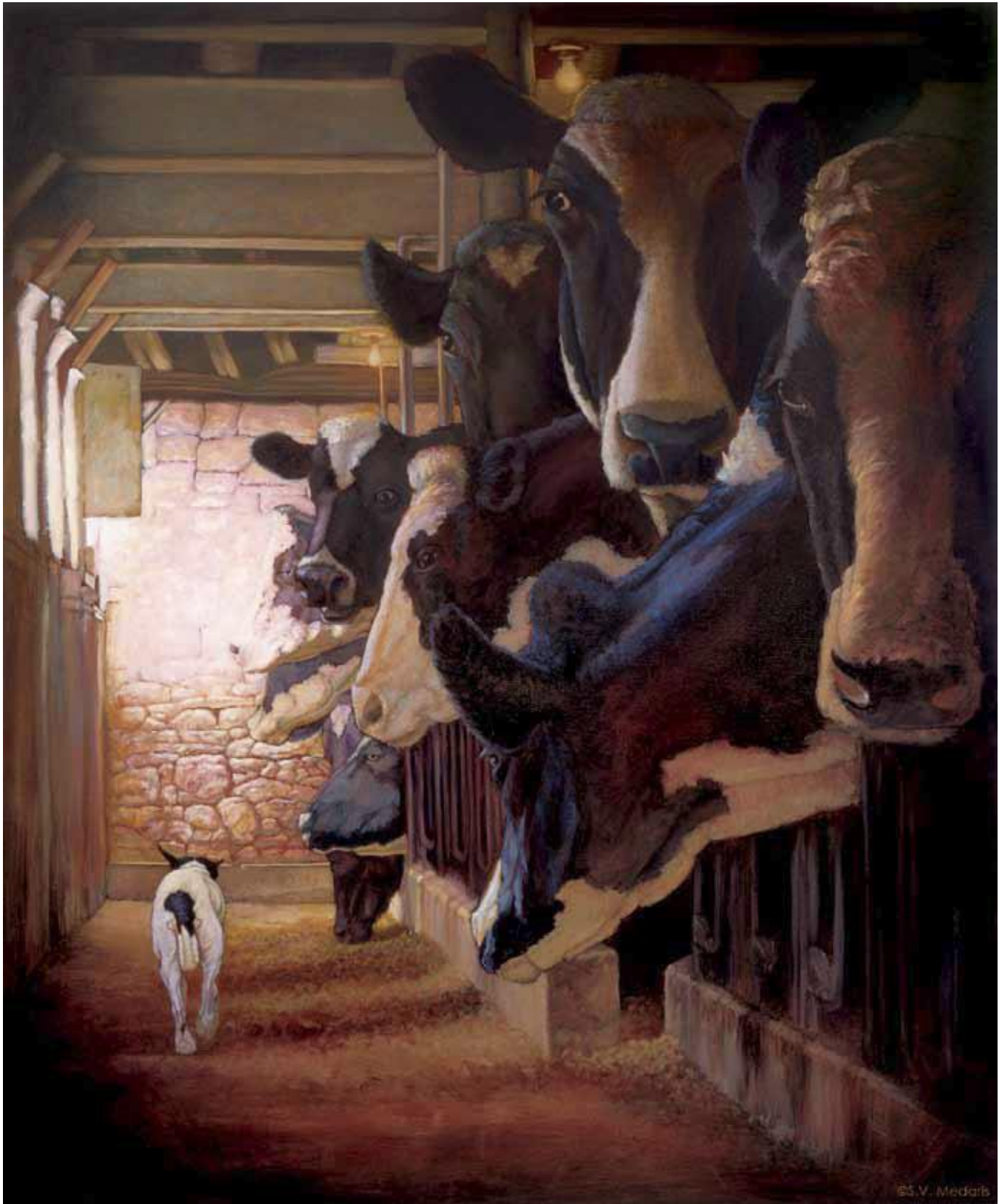

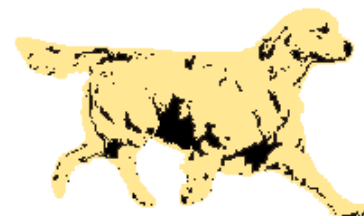

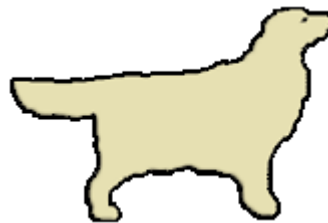
